## **INFORMATION BULLETIN 2005-02**

### **SUBJECT: APMC DESIGNATIONS APMC-601, 620 SERIES, 611 & 700 FORM REPORTING**

The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to provide an updated list of important designations that affect companies required to report on the APMC-601, 620 Series, 611 & 700 forms.

#### **APMC-601 – APMC Designated Gas Transmission Pipelines and Field Locations**

This form is reported by buyers who purchase marketable Alberta natural gas at a field location. A field location is defined as a receipt meter station of a gas transmission pipeline but does not include a receipt meter at an interconnection point within a gas transmission pipeline or between gas transmission pipelines, or at a gas storage facility. Purchases occurring within close proximity of the inlet of a receipt meter station would be considered as located at a field location, where purchased quantities are supported directly or indirectly by measurements at the receipt meter of the gas transmission pipeline.

The following are gas transmission pipelines for purposes of information reporting under Part 3 of the Natural Gas Marketing Regulation. This list includes NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. and APMC designated gas transmission pipelines.

### **APMC-620 Series – APMC Designated Distributors**

The APMC-621, 622, 623, and 624 forms are reported by a company that distributes gas within Alberta, which has been designated as a distributor by the APMC. The APMC-625 form is reported by an end-user or end-user agent that sells gas to a distributor under buy/sell arrangements. The following companies have been designated as distributors by the APMC for purposes of the Natural Gas Marketing Regulation.

### **APMC-611 & 700 – APMC Designated Mainline Straddle Plants**

The APMC-611 is reported by a user of marketable gas at a large-volume end-use facility. A type of large-volume end-use facility is the mainline straddle plant, which has been designated as a mainline straddle plant by the APMC for purposes of the Natural Gas Marketing Regulation.

The APMC-700 is reported by an operator of a mainline straddle plant.
