Based on the feedback received at last year's Information Exchange, the DoE asked the ERCB to include a presentation on spacing unit orders and holdings.

The ERCB presented information on drilling spacing units and target areas, regional area of increased well densities, fractional lands and holdings and demonstrated where to find spacing information on their website.

ETS BEST PRACTICES

Security (passwords and client accounts), available rights query, query by map and land, posting, bidding, banking information and the sales results map were discussed and best practices were highlighted.

CONTINUATIONS BEST PRACTICES
